

BIBLE MEMORY VERSES

1. John 3:16 For God so loved the world, that he gave his only begotten Son, that whosoever believeth in him should not perish, but have everlasting life.
2. Philippians 4:13 I can do all things through Christ which strengtheneth me.
3. John 11:35 Jesus wept.
4. Matthew 6:33 But seek ye first the kingdom of God, and his righteousness; and all these things shall be added unto you.
5. Psalms 23:1 The LORD is my shepherd; I shall not want
6. Psalms 100:5 For the LORD is good; his mercy is everlasting; and his truth endureth to all generations.
7. John 1:1 In the beginning was the Word, and the Word was with God, and the Word was God.
8. Matthew 5:6 Blessed are they which do hunger and thirst after righteousness: for they shall be filled.
9. Matthew 5:14 Ye are the light of the world. A city that is set on an hill cannot be hid.
10. Hebrews 11:1 Now faith is the substance of things hoped for, the evidence of things not seen.
11. Hebrews 11:6 But without faith it is impossible to please him: for he that cometh to God must believe that he is, and that he is a rewarder of them that diligently seek him.
12. I Samuel 15:22c Behold, to obey is better than sacrifice, and to hearken than the fat of rams.
13. Genesis 1:1 In the beginning God created the heaven and the earth.
14. Genesis 1:26a And God said, Let us make man in our image, after our likeness.
15. II Chronicles 7:14 If my people, which are called by my name, shall humble themselves, and pray, and seek my face, and turn from their wicked ways; then I will hear from heaven, and will forgive their sin, and will heal their land.
16. Psalms 100:1 Make a joyful noise unto the LORD, all ye lands.
17. Matthew 1:21 And she shall bring forth a son, and thou shalt call his name JESUS: for he shall save his people from their sins.
18. Acts 1:8 But ye shall receive power, after the Holy Ghost is come upon you: and ye shall be witnesses unto me both in Jerusalem, and in all Judea, and in Samaria, and unto the uttermost part of the earth.
19. I John 1:9 If we confess our sins, he is faithful and just to forgive us our sins, and to cleanse us from all unrighteousness.
20. I John 2:15 Love not the world, neither the things that are in the world. If any man love the world, the love of the Father is not in him.
21. Revelation 3:20 Behold, I stand at the door, and knock: if any man hear my voice, and open the door, I will come in to him, and will sup with him, and he with me.
22. Psalms 8:1 O LORD our Lord, how excellent is thy name in all the earth! Who hast set thy glory above the heavens.
23. Psalms 103:1 Bless the LORD, O my soul: and all that is within me, bless his holy name.
24. Psalms 103:2 Bless the LORD, O my soul, and forget not all his benefits.

25. 2 Corinthians 13:5 Examine yourself, whether ye be in the faith; prove your own selves.
26. Mark 11:24 Therefore I say unto you, what things soever ye desire, when ye pray, believe that ye receive them, and ye shall have them.
27. Luke 2:14 Glory to God in the highest, and on earth peace, good will toward men.
28. Romans 8:28 And we know that all things work together for good to them that love God, to them who are the called according to his purpose.
29. Romans 8:1 There is therefore now no condemnation to them which are in Christ Jesus, who walk not after the flesh, but after the Spirit.
30. Jeremiah 29:11 For I know the thoughts that I think toward you, saith the LORD, thoughts of peace, and not of evil, to give you an expected end.
31. Isaiah 40:31 But they that wait upon the LORD shall renew their strength; they shall mount up with wings as eagles; they shall run, and not be weary; and they shall walk, and not faint.
32. John 8:32 And ye shall know the truth, and the truth shall make you free.
33. Galatians 6:2 Bear ye one another's burdens, and so fulfill the law of Christ.
34. Philippians 1:6 Being confident of this very thing, that he which hath begun a good work in you will perform it until the day of Jesus Christ.
35. Philippians 1:21 For to me to live is Christ, and to die is gain.
36. John 8:36 If the Son therefore shall make you free, ye shall be free indeed.
37. Luke 1:37 For with God nothing shall be impossible.
38. Romans 8:38 For I am persuaded, that neither death, nor life, nor angels, nor principalities, nor powers, nor things present, nor things to come
39. Romans 8:39 Nor height, nor depth, nor any other creature, shall be able to separate us from the love of God, which is in Christ Jesus our Lord.
40. Romans 12:1 I beseech you therefore, brethren, by the mercies of God, that ye present your bodies a living sacrifice, holy, acceptable unto God, which is your reasonable service.
41. Isaiah 41:10 Fear thou not; for I am with thee: be not dismayed; for I am thy God: I will strengthen thee; yea, I will help thee; yea, I will uphold thee with the right hand of my righteousness.
42. James 3:8 But the tongue can no man tame; it is an unruly evil, full of deadly poison.
43. Isaiah 43:1b Fear not: for I have redeemed thee, I have called thee by thy name; thou art mine.
44. I Corinthians 16:14 Let all your things be done with charity.
45. I Corinthians 10:13 There hath no temptation taken you but such as is common to man: but God is faithful, who will not suffer you to be tempted above that ye are able: but will with the temptation also, make a way to escape, that ye may be able to bear it.
46. Psalms 46:1 GOD is our refuge and strength, a very present help in trouble.
47. I Corinthians 14:40 Let all things be done decently and in order.
48. Psalms 46 Be still, and know that I am God: I will be exalted among the heathen, I will be exalted in the earth.

49. Ecclesiastes 3:1 To every thing there is a season, and a time to every purpose under the heaven.
50. Galatians 5:1 Stand fast therefore in the liberty wherewith Christ hath made us free, and be not entangled again with the yoke of bondage.
51. Psalms 51:10 Create in me a clean heart, O God; and renew a right spirit within me.
52. John 3:3 Jesus answered and said unto him, Verily, verily, I say unto thee, Except a man be born again, he cannot see the kingdom of God.
53. Isaiah 53:5 But he was wounded for our transgressions, he was bruised for our iniquities: the chastisement of our peace was upon him; and with his stripes we are healed.
54. John 3:6 That which is born of the flesh is flesh; and that which is born of the Spirit is spirit.
55. I Corinthians 15:55 O death, where is thy sting? O grave, where is thy victory?
56. II Timothy 2:15 Study to show thyself approved unto God, a workman that needeth not to be ashamed, rightly dividing the word of truth.
57. I Peter 5:7 Casting all your care upon him; for he careth for you.
58. I Corinthians 15:58 Therefore, my beloved brethren, be ye steadfast, unmoveable, always abounding in the work of the Lord, forasmuch as ye know that your labor is not in vain in the Lord.
59. I John 4:7 Beloved, let us love one another: for love is of God; and every one that loveth is born of God, and knoweth God.
60. I John 4:8 He that loveth not knoweth not God; for God is love.
61. Isaiah 61:1 The Spirit of the Lord GOD is upon me; because the LORD hath anointed me to preach good tidings unto the meek; he hath sent me to bind up the brokenhearted, to proclaim liberty to the captives, and the opening of the prison to them that are bound.
62. James 1:2 My brethren, count it all joy when ye fall into divers temptations.
63. James 1:8 A double minded man is unstable in all his ways.
64. Galatians 5:22 But the fruit of the Spirit is love, joy, peace, longsuffering, gentleness, goodness, faith
65. Galatians 5:23 Meekness, temperance: against such there is no law.
66. Psalms 66:18 If I regard iniquity in my heart, the Lord will not hear me.
67. Psalms 119:67 Before I was afflicted I went astray: but now have I kept thy word.
68. Isaiah 50:4 The Lord GOD hath given me the tongue of the learned, that I should know how to speak a word in season to him that is weary: he wakeneth morning by morning, he wakeneth mine ear to hear as the learned.
69. I Thessalonians 5:17 Pray without ceasing.
70. Colossians 3:23 And whatsoever ye do, do it heartily, as to the Lord, and not unto men.
71. Psalms 119:71 It is good for me that I have been afflicted; that I might learn thy statutes.
72. Acts 2:17 And it shall come to pass in the last days, saith God, I will pour out my Spirit upon all flesh: and your sons and your daughters shall prophesy, and your young men shall see visions, and your old men shall dream dreams.
73. Acts 2:21 And it shall come to pass, that whosoever shall call on the name of the Lord shall be saved.

74. I Corinthians 6:19 What? Know ye not that your body is the temple of the Holy Ghost which is in you, which ye have of God, and ye are not your own?
75. II Timothy 4:7 I have fought a good fight, I have finished my course, I have kept the faith.
76. Deuteronomy 6:4 Hear, O Israel: The LORD our God is one LORD.
77. Nehemiah 8:10c for the joy of the LORD is your strength.
78. Genesis 18:14a Is any thing too hard for the LORD?
79. Luke 10:27 And he answering said, Thou shalt love the Lord thy God with all thy heart, and with all thy soul, and with all thy strength, and with all thy mind; and thy neighbor as thyself.
80. Romans 12:21 Be not overcome of evil, but overcome evil with good.
81. Matthew 7:1 Ask, and it shall be given you; seek, and ye shall find; knock, and it shall be opened unto you.
82. Matthew 11:30 For my yoke is easy, and my burden is light.
83. Psalms 121:1 I will lift up mine eyes unto the hills, from whence cometh my help.
84. Psalms 121:2 My help cometh from the Lord, which made heaven and earth.
85. Titus 1:15a Unto the pure all things are pure.
86. Ephesians 6:1 Children, obey your parents in the Lord: for this is right.
87. Ephesians 6:2 Honor thy father and mother; which is the first commandment with promise.
88. Ephesians 6:3 That it may be well with thee, and thou mayest live long on the earth.
89. Ephesians 6:4 And, ye fathers, provoke not your children to wrath: but bring them up in the nurture and admonition of the Lord.
90. Philippians 4:8 Finally, brethren, whatsoever things are true, whatsoever things are honest, whatsoever things are just, whatsoever things are pure, whatsoever things are lovely, whatsoever thing are of good report; if there be any virtue, and if there be any praise, thing on these things.
91. Psalms 91:1 He that dwelleth in the secret place of the most High shall abide under the shadow of the Almighty.
92. Colossians 3:1 If ye then be risen with Christ, seek those things which are above, where Christ sitteth on the right hand of God.
93. I Peter 5:6 Humble yourselves therefore under the mighty had of God, that he may exalt you in due time.
94. Psalms 1:1 Blessed is the man that walketh not in the counsel of the ungodly, nor standeth in the way of sinners, nor sitteth in the seat of the scornful.
95. Matthew 5:48 Be ye therefore perfect, even as your Father which is in heaven is perfect.
96. Matthew 6:9 After this manner therefore pray ye: Our Father which art in heaven, Hallowed be thy name.
97. Matthew 5:44 But I say unto you, Love your enemies, bless them that curse you, do good to them that hate you, and pray for them which despitefully use you, and persecute you.
98. Galatians 6:7 Be not deceived; God is not mocked: for whatsoever a man soweth, that shall he also reap.
99. Romans 1:16 For I am not ashamed of the gospel of Christ: for it is the power of God unto salvation to every one that believeth; to the Jew first, and also to the Greek.
100. John 15:7 If ye abide in me, and my words abide in you, ye shall ask what ye will, and it shall be done unto you.
101. Galatians 6:9 And let us not be weary in well doing: for in due season we shall reap, if we faint not.
